- ※Master's Program Students of GINPPA are required to take 4 "Basic Core Courses" totaling 9 credits (including "Thesis Writing", a compulsory non-credit course), as well as 3 "Major Elective Courses" for at least 3 credits each, totaling 9 credits. The remaining credits can be selected freely according to students' needs. The graduation thesis is worth 6 credits. A total of 42 credits (including the graduation thesis) are required to graduate.
